Celebration of Baptism

Today we get to celebrate with Alice and Gwen Ratcliff, daughters of Katie Miner & Walter Ratcliff, as they are welcomed into the family of faith through the Sacrament of Holy Baptism!

What is Baptism?

Baptism is one of two sacraments (more on that in another bulletin!) that Lutherans recognize. The word baptize comes from Greek and means "to apply water," and there's not really any difference whether that application is a dunk or a sprinkle, a font or a river! All that is needed for baptism is water and the Word of God. While some traditions have folks wait until they're older to be baptized (sometimes called "believer's baptism"), Lutherans and some other denominations have traditionally celebrated infant baptism (though we do baptize adults who have not been baptized as children). This again is not a matter of "right or wrong"; every baptism is held as sacred. We baptize infants because in this sacrament, we hear God's unconditional "Yes!" spoken to each of us as a gift we cannot earn or deserve, and God's promise cannot, and will not, be broken. Thanks be to God!
