## We Welcome the Joy, Laughter, Sights, and Sounds of Children in Worship!

There are children's activity bulletins and worship activity bags available - just ask our ushers. If a moment out of the sanctuary is needed, a toy-filled nursery and changing table are available too, however, we ask that an adult family member stay present at all times.

## What is the Lectionary?

Have you ever wondered where the readings that we hear in worship come from? Many congregations from Baptist, Roman Catholic, Episcopal, Methodist, Presbyterian, and Lutheran traditions, including St. Mark's, follow what is called the Revised Common Lectionary (RCL). The RCL sets four readings for each Sunday; a reading from the Old Testament (except during the season of Easter, when the first lesson comes from Acts), a Psalm, a reading from one of the New Testament epistles, and a reading from the Gospels. The RCL follows a three year cycle in which the Gospel readings come from Matthew in Year A, Mark in Year B, and Luke in Year C, with John appearing a little bit throughout.

There is nothing sacred about the RCL itself; some churches follow other lectionaries like the Narrative Lectionary, a four-year cycle that focuses on one primary text each week and seeks to tell a continuous story throughout the year. Other congregations don't follow a lectionary and choose readings according to whatever the preacher feels led to speak on. One of the benefits of the RCL, however, is that when we come to worship, we know we are hearing the same Word today as so many other Christians across the country and around the world.
