Blessed Blessings

We often make two assumptions about blessing; one, that it is something God does for us, and two, that blessing has something to do with material benefit. While both things can be true, blessing is also a deeply important part of the Christian life, and it runs so much deeper than our material possessions. The scriptures speak of Jacob, Simeon, and many others speaking blessing over people, places, and things; the Psalmist even blesses God! When we speak a blessing, we are affirming the goodness of the person or thing being blessed, and we declare our confident hope that God will use what has been blessed for good. Today, we are blessing quilts and care kits, that they might be a benefit to all who receive them. How might you practice blessing more intentionally in your daily life?
