Make a Joyful Noise

Music has always been a deeply important part of worship. From the Psalmist's exhortation to "sing to the LORD a new song," to Paul's appeal in both Ephesians and Colossians to "sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God," the Bible is sees music as integral to worship. There are many ways to be faithful in making music that honors God. Some traditions only sing a capella, and instruments are not allowed in worship. Some churches have big pipe organs and sing very traditional hymns. Some have praise bands that lead worship through music you might hear on the radio. Some churches even find it most authentic to worship through jazz, bluegrass, or folk music. What matters to God is not the style of music or the instruments that accompany it, but the attitudes of our hearts as we "make a joyful noise to the LORD." Let us glorify God by making all kinds of music together!
