which means none are turned away from Christ's table. We believe Christ is fully present in the bread and wine, and no less present in our gluten-free and alcohol-free options. If you wish instead to receive a blessing, you may signify this by crossing your arms over your chest.

# We Welcome the Joy, Laughter, Sights, and Sounds of Children in Worship!

There are children's activity bulletins and worship activity bags available - just ask our ushers. If a moment out of the sanctuary is needed, a toy-filled nursery and changing table are available too, however, we ask that an adult family member stay present at all times.

# Do This in Remembrance of Me

We hear those words almost every week as we come to the table to receive a bit of bread and a sip of wine. We say these things are the body and blood of Christ, in whatever form we receive them; bread, wafer, intinction, individual cups, gluten free or alcohol free. Some Christians understand this to be a symbolic act, but Lutherans have held to the belief that this bread and wine truly is Christ's body and blood, not through some act of magic but simply because Jesus said so. We come to the table with believers around the globe and across the ages to receive a gift of grace we have not earned. Some call this meal "communion" in recognition of the power it has to bind us together. Some call this meal "eucharist," from the Greek for "giving thanks." Whatever you call it, however you receive it, this is the body and blood of Christ given for you. Thanks be to God.
