

which means none are turned away from Christ's table. We believe Christ is fully present in the bread and wine, and no less present in our gluten-free and alcohol-free options. If you wish instead to receive a blessing, you may signify this by crossing your arms over your chest.

We Welcome the Joy, Laughter, Sights, and Sounds of Children in Worship!

There are children's activity bulletins and worship activity bags available - just ask our ushers. If a moment out of the sanctuary is needed, a toy-filled nursery and changing table are available too, however, we ask that an adult family member stay present at all times.

The Words of Institution

Most every week, we gather at the table to receive holy communion. Whenever we do, we hear certain words spoken: "On the night in which he was betrayed..." These words, called the "Words of Institution" are taken from 1 Corinthians 11:23-26, and they recall the events of the Last Supper, when Jesus sat at the table with his disciples and shared one final meal with them. The Words of Institution remind us what it is that we receive: the body and blood of Christ, given in bread and wine. Moreover, they call us to remember; not just the events that took place in the upper room, but the whole life of love laid down for us. In this meal of remembrance, may we find the strength to pattern our lives after Jesus, so that the old saying might be true: you are what you eat.
