Powerful Prayers

Prayer is an important part of our weekly worship, but it's also a vital part of the Christian life the rest of the week. But that doesn't mean it's always easy; even the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how! We can use pre-written prayers, or we can pray from the heart. We can pray out loud or silently. We can pray on our knees with our hands folded or standing up with our arms outstretched. No matter how we pray, prayer involves communication. We bring God our hurts and our hopes, our joys and our concerns. Just as important is that we learn how to listen for God to answer. God speaks to us in scripture and through the people in our lives. The more we pray, the more we find our lives aligning with God's will.
