Baptism

Today we celebrate the baptism of Elizabeth Nicole Carter and Jacob Allen Carter. In Holy Baptism, God makes promises to us, and we make promises to God. God's promise to us is an irrevocable "yes"; God claims us and calls us "Beloved," and there is nothing that can take away God's love for us. Secure in God's "yes," we make promises as well: to gather with the community of believers, to learn God's word and participate in the sacraments, to share the Good News of God's love, to follow Jesus' example in serving others, and to work for justice and peace in the world. While Lutherans often baptize infants (a reminder that there is nothing we have to do to earn God's "yes"), there is no wrong time to come to the waters and be washed in God's love. As we celebrate today with Lizzie and Jake, may we all remember our own baptism, and affirm our commitment to following in the ways of Jesus.
