which means none are turned away from Christ's table. We believe Christ is fully present in the bread and wine, and no less present in our gluten-free and alcohol-free options. If you wish instead to receive a blessing, you may signify this by crossing your arms over your chest.

#### We Welcome the Joy, Laughter, Sights, and Sounds of Children in Worship!

There are children's activity bulletins and worship activity bags available - just ask our ushers. If a moment out of the sanctuary is needed, a toy-filled nursery and changing table are available too, however, we ask that an adult family member stay present at all times.

## Revealing God in the Worship Space: Paraments

You may have noticed that the paraments changed from white to green today. From the Latin word "paramentum," which means "to adorn," the paraments are the cloth hangings on the lectern, the pulpit and the communion table. The colors change according to the season of the church year, representing major themes of the season. During Christmas, Easter, and certain festival days, the color is white, symbolizing holiness. During Advent, the color is blue, representing hope and expectation. In Lent, the color is purple, representing both royalty and repentance. For Pentecost and Reformation, the paraments are red, a symbol of the Holy Spirit. And in the Sundays after both Epiphany and Pentecost, the color is green, a symbol of growth in faith and life. The paraments are also adorned with symbols, such as the Alpha and Omega, which reminds us that God is both the beginning and the end of our lives. Through both color and symbolism, the paraments are a visual reminder of the Christian story throughout the year.
