Behold, the Life-Giving Cross

During Epiphany, we've learned about some of the ways our sanctuary points to God through symbols and adornments. Perhaps the most well-known symbol of our faith is the cross. For Christians, the cross stands as a reminder of Jesus' death for the sake of the world. An empty cross reminds us that Jesus rose again in assurance of the resurrection promised to us; a cross that bears the image of Jesus' body (a crucifix) is a reminder of Jesus' sacrificial love for us. In our sanctuary, there are several crosses: some are part of the design of the carpet, or atop the hymn boards and columbarium. The most prominent cross stands at the front of the sanctuary and has a Christogram, the letters IHS (a shortened form of the Latin spelling of Jesus' name), in the center. Our processional cross bears the symbols for each of the evangelists on the arms, with a lamb in the center, representing Christ; during Lent, we use a crucifix for our processional cross. Where else have you seen crosses as a reminder of your faith?
