This year, we're going to approach Lent through the lens of Broken and Blessed. On Wednesdays we'll gather in the Fellowship Hall to worship around the table together, and we'll have the opportunity to reflect on some of the things that cause brokenness in our world; not just sin, but grief, despair, fear, resentment, and failure. On Sundays, we'll be reminded that the God who sees our brokenness also calls us blessed, and restores us to life through gifts of mercy, empathy, joy, hospitality, generosity, & praise. We'll journey together through this season of penitence and preparation, in all our blessed brokenness, until we reach the foot of the cross, where we are invited to lay our burdens down and be held by the wounded hands of Christ.
