Learn About Lent

The liturgical season of Lent is a time of penitence and preparation. It spans 40 days (not counting Sundays) from Ash Wednesday to Easter; a reminder of the 40 days during which Christ was tested in the wilderness before beginning his public ministry. In the early Church, this season was particularly dedicated to catechesis, teaching new Christians what they needed to know in preparation for baptism during the Easter vigil. The observance of Lent has tended to focus on three "pillars" of discipline: fasting, almsgiving, and prayer. These Lenten pillars are meant to help orient the practitioner toward right relationship with themselves (fasting), their neighbor (almsgiving), and God (prayer). As we walk the road together in this Lenten season, we invite you to consider how these practices might be meaningful in your own faith life, both during this season and throughout the year.

Easter Flowers
