Where Did The Alleluia Go?

Throughout the Church year, we prepare to hear the gospel reading with a sung Gospel Acclamation. During the season of Lent, however, the Gospel Acclamation is a bit different from the rest of the year. In Lent, a season of penitence and self-reflection, churches traditionally shift away from exuberant praise, opting instead for a more reflective song. "Let your steadfast love come to us, O Lord" or "Return to the Lord, your God" are common Lenten themes for the Gospel Acclamation. As we sing these words together, we prepare our hearts and minds to receive God's word with a mirror turned on ourselves, examining our need for a Savior. At Easter, the Gospel Acclamation returns to its usual focus, singing praise to the God who has saved us in endless love.
