Our procession begins with use of an incense Thurible. In the Hebrew Scriptures, incense was burned to prepare a space for sinful human beings to enter into the presence of the holy God. The psalmist prays that their prayers might be like incense before the Lord, a pleasing smell rising to God's attention. Christian worship over the centuries has incorporated the use of incense as a reminder that our prayers are pleasing and acceptable to the God who is with us and for us. Though we don't incorporate the use of incense every Sunday, on festival days, it is an appropriate addition to worship

St. Mark's celebrates open communion which means none are turned away from Christ's table. We believe Christ is fully present in the bread and wine, and no less present in our gluten-free and alcohol-free options. If you wish instead to receive a blessing, you may signify this by crossing your arms over your chest.

Distribution & Flowering of the Cross

We flower a cross on Easter morning in celebration of new life in Christ. On Good Friday, the empty cross is brought into the sanctuary and laid with a crown of thorns. On Easter, the crown has been removed and the cross will be filled with live flowers as an illustration of the life, joy, and beauty found in the risen Lord. With a desire for all to participate, you are invited to use the flowers you brought or the ones provided to decorate the cross as you go to communion. After worship, the cross will be available outside for Easter pictures.
